It is expected that children wear a school jumper/cardigan with logo - these can be purchased from Gooddies, our school supplier, or second-hand. All other items of clothing do not need to display the school logo.

We have a wide selection of second-hand uniform available in the school office free of charge.

PLEASE ENSURE THAT ALL ITEMS ARE CLEARLY LABELLED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME

Shoes	Sturdy black leather school shoes or plain black trainers (daily use and for PE) A pair of wellies for outdoor learning and play
Socks	Plain white or grey socks, or grey tights
Trousers/skirt	Plain charcoal grey trousers, skirt or pinafore Plain charcoal grey shorts or pale blue and white checked dress - for the summer months
Tops	Plain pale blue polo shirt Royal blue Middle Barton School sweatshirt or cardigan with logo, available from Gooddies, via the school website: https://www.middlebartonschool.org/school-uniform/
PE kit- children come to school dressed in their PE kit on the days they have PE and wear it for the day.	Plain pale blue polo shirt (same as above) or T shirt Plain navy blue shorts Plain navy blue tracksuit bottoms School jumper or plain navy blue jumper or tracksuit top Trainers (as above or if they are just for PE can be any colour)
Swimming kit for allocated sessions	Trunks (not shorts) or one-piece costume Swimming hat Towel
Hair and jewellery	Long hair must be kept tied back Simple stud earrings may be worn but must be removed for PE. Watches may be worn by Y3-6 and must be removed for PE. The school accepts no responsibility for loss or damage.
Additional items	Water bottle Book bag/School bag
